Each fall during the month of September, students enrolled in kindergarten will receive vision and hearing screenings performed by Kenosha Unified School District staff. Parents will be notified of any concerns in either of these areas, including recommendations for appropriate follow-up care.

The information you provide by completing the Kindergarten Screening Information Form is important to the educational team and to all involved in planning your child's educational program.

Your child's kindergarten teacher will receive the Kindergarten Screening Information Form. Other school personnel, such as the school counselor, school psychologist, speech therapist or resource teacher, may also read this form. This confidential form will be placed in your child's student records folder.

Please complete the Kindergarten Screening Information Form and return it to the school office. If you have questions regarding your child's participation in the vision and hearing screening process, or do not want them to participate, please contact the school office.
