One individual nominator should solicit all nomination letters, ensure that the attached criteria are met and submit them as a complete package.

The maximum number of letters of recommendation is **10** per nominee. Letters signed by groups of people will not be accepted. Do not submit nomination letters online.

Collectively, letters should provide detail and examples based on the criteria. Albums, photographs, electronic media, multimedia, newspaper clippings, videos, audiotapes, slideshows or booklets will not be accepted.

Please refer to the attached documents for the names of previous award recipients. Previous recipients are ineligible to receive the same award more than once.

A person nominated who did not receive an award maybe re-activated the next year. Her or his file may be re-activated by using last year's packet. However, several current letters would be beneficial to include so that the file is current.

Award recipients must be present at the annual Recognition Dinner to be honored.

## TEACHER OF THE YEAR CRITERIA

(One award for each of the following: elementary, middle, high school and special area award)

- **Relationships:** Fosters positive relationships with students; respects individual interests and needs; collaborates with colleagues, parents and agencies to support student learning; demonstrates integrity and ensures equity.
- **Innovation:** Adapts instruction to meet the diverse needs of students; implements new ideas or approaches when working with children.
- **Instruction:** Provides instruction that supports the broad range of students' intellectual, social and personal development; uses a variety of instructional strategies, including technology to encourage development of critical thinking, problem solving and performance skills; develops lessons from data collected through formal and informal assessment strategies to evaluate and ensure the continuous growth of all students.
- **Communication:** Uses effective communication techniques, including technology, to foster active inquiry, collaboration and support for students and parents.
- **Professionalism:** A reflective practitioner who continually evaluates his or her choices and actions on students, parents and professionals in the learning community; actively engages in professional development; organizations, committees, workshops, conferences; a leader and role model.

## ADMINISTRATOR OF THE YEAR CRITERIA

(Only one recipient will be chosen for this award)

- **Relationships:** Has a positive relationship with all constituencies; thinks about the interests and needs of others; and is considered approachable by all.
- **Administrative skills:** Possesses strong administrative and communication skills; is well-organized and has the ability to resolve a crisis in an expeditious manner.
- **School/departmental leadership:** Ensures the effectiveness of his/her school or department and firmly believes that supporting the instructional process is a key to the improvement of the district.
- **Service:** Commitment to young people and staff goes beyond the school day; is involved with community or civic organizations and gives that "extra" to his/her school or department.
- **District leadership:** An exemplary leader that is well respected by district staff as a leader and role model.

- **Professional development:** A continuous learner involved with professional organizations, committees, commissions and task forces; conducts seminars and presentations using effective instructional strategies and data.

### **DISTINGUISHED SERVICE CRITERIA**

**(Eight awards)**

- **Impact of contribution:** Impacts the educational community and greatly affects the student learning environment.
- **Service to School:** Commitment to educational process goes beyond the school day.
- **Relationships:** Has a positive relationship and is respected by staff, parents and/or students.
