Section 19.82(2), Wisconsin Statutes, states in part as follows:

To the extent that four or more members of the School Board actually attend, the above listed event may be rebuttably presumed to be a meeting within the meaning of Wisconsin's open meeting law. Notice is, therefore, given. There will be no votes taken by the Board of Education.
