WOMEN'S VOLLEYBALL LEAGUE - SPRING 2017

NOTE: Recreation Department /Registration times: 7:30 A.M. to 3:45 P.M.

The Department of Recreation will offer Women's Volleyball Leagues for women 16 years of age or older. The **Power Leagues** will play on **Monday**, beginning on **January 30 at Lance & Washington Middle Schools** from 7:00 to 9:00 p.m. for a period of 10 weeks. The **Recreation Leagues** will play on **Tuesday** at **Lance Middle School** beginning **January 31** and on **Wednesday at Lance Middle School** beginning on **February 1** from 7:00 to 9:00 p.m. for a period of 10 weeks.



SIGN UP PROCEDURE

Registration for the team must be made at the Department of Recreation, 2717-67th Street. A player can play in more than (1) one volleyball league, but only one league per night. Teams that signed up for the fall leagues and requested to reserve their spot for spring, will be given a one day sign up to get their spot back in the spring. The designated day will be **Monday, January 9th**. Teams will have from **7:30 a.m. until 3:45 p.m. on Monday the 9th** to claim their reserved spot. If a team does not sign up their team on this designated day, the reserved spot will be advertised as an open spot for another team to sign up starting on Tuesday, January 10th, 2017.

If a team wants to change their night/school of play from the fall reserved spot they would have to check with the Recreation Department on Tuesday, January 10th. Starting on Tuesday, January 10th registration will be on a first come first serve basis.

The minimum number of players on a team is six and maximum is eight players. No members of any school women's volleyball teams are eligible to play in the program. The program will be limited to eight teams in each league.
