Dear Parent/Guardians and Students:

Students in grades 1-8 who are attending The Kenosha eSchool program will take the MAPS "Measures of Academic Progress" assessment during the week of September 16. The MAP's test is a computer-adaptive assessment tool that KUSD uses as a benchmark to monitor student growth and to identify academic development in both reading and math.

Testing will be administered to students in person at the eSchool building located at 8518 22nd Avenue. (Please note that we share a building with Ruth Harman Academy.) Students are to enter the building at door 13 located on the northeast corner of the building. Parents who want to walk their child into the building can park on the North or East side of the building. (See the attached MAP.) The duration of the test is approximately two hours. It is an untimed test so the amount of time needed varies by the individual student.

There are two dates you can choose to have your child complete the MAPS test. (Students only need to attend one session.) Please reference the schedule below.

Please have your child bring their school issued Chromebook fully charged on testing day.


